	Drop-Off 9am <i>Parents can arrive up to 5 mins early for drop off.</i>
9:00	Opening Prayer & Worship <i>Start day with outdoor exploration, movement and play then worship time before beginning classes.</i>
9:30 - 12:00 *Snack at 10am	Language Arts & Math <i>Small group academic instruction for Language Arts and Math based on student skill level per subject. We will utilize Master Books Christian Homeschool Curriculum and additionally supplement with active, fun and hands-on learning opportunities during morning academic instruction.</i> <i>Our goal is to support Parent Educators by providing quality instruction for these subjects during our programming day(s), and offer support, accountability and structure to progress students through completion of these subjects over the programming year. Students will have some TOL required additional lesson(s)/review to complete during the remainder of the week.</i>
12:00	Lunch & Outdoor Play <i>Children are given a full hour for lunch and free play (outside as often as possible). They will be well-supervised while allowed to freely explore and play with peers. We believe outdoor time and free play are essential for physical, cognitive and social development.</i>
1:00 - 2:30	Cross Curricular Interests & Homesteading Sciences <i>Cross-curricular unit studies and class projects, loosely based on student interests, will offer a blend of Bible-teaching, science, history and STEAM learning (science/technology/engineering/art/mathematics). The afternoon session will have ongoing themes of faith and homesteading sciences (gardens, animals - fun!).</i> <i>We are exploring additional options to supplement our afternoons session and considering using some portions of Master Books, Campfire Curriculums and Exodus WildSchool.</i>
